



Re. 2022 Sheetiron 300 Dualsport

Dear Dualsport Enthusiast:

Thank you for your interest in Oakland Motorcycle Club's 2022 Sheetiron 300 Dualsport event.

I regret to inform you that the event has been sold out this year. We are obligated to limit the riders to a maximum of 500. Our insurance, U.S. Forest Service permit restrictions, and the ability of our organization to manage a larger number of riders require this limit.

Note that there are always cancelations for this event, as the plans for the participants may change unexpectedly. Your entry and entries received after the 500-rider cutoff have been placed on a waiting list in the order in which they were received. (An entry with a check is required to be placed on the waiting list.) If you would like to be removed from the waiting list, please e-mail me at snyderbt@comcast.net, and your check will be returned.

I will contact riders on the waiting list as slots become available. Please be prepared for the ride by having your bike ready and by making cancelable motel reservations in Fort Bragg. Note that most cancelation occur very close to the event date. If you do not respond within 24 hours to my email or phone call, you will be dropped from the waiting list.

We encourage you to apply for this event next year. It is always held on the weekend before the Memorial Day weekend. Flyers with applications are posted on our Website by mid-March. Entries are accepted beginning April 1. We will accept entries until we reach the maximum number of riders for the year.

Thanks again for your interest, and I hope to see you in Stonyford next year.
